#### **Approve Agenda**

#### **Action Items/New Business**

Discussion and possible action to address requiring students and staff to wear facemasks as part of the District's Health Safety Plan to address Covid-19.

He went through the implications of eliminating the mask mandate at school and the possible effects on student learning and staffing.
